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Subject: Matter related to grant of permission to the Shree Saptashrunji Ayurved Mahavidyalaya & Hospital, Kamal Nagar, Hirawadi, Panchavati, Nasik- 422003, Maharashtra to start new Post Graduate Course of Study in 07 subjects namely (i) *Samhita Siddhant*, (ii) *Kriya Sharir*, (iii) *Dravyaguna*, (iv) *Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana*, (v) *Kaumarbhritya*, (vi) *Agad Tantra* and (vii) *Panchakarma* with 06 seats in each subject and to increase the admission capacity from 50 to 60 seats in existing UG course from the academic session 2014-15 to the academic session 2018-19 Under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 - reg.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to the Department's letter of even No. dated 15.05.2014 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of recommendations of the CCIM in terms of the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant regulations made thereunder and approved norms for academic session 2014-15, which were circulated vide Department's letter No.R.11011/10/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 17.06.2014 to all the ASU Colleges, Universities and State Governments and also available on Department's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>); permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Shree Saptashrunji Ayurved Mahavidyalaya & Hospital, Kamal Nagar, Hirawadi, Panchavati, Nasik- 422003, Maharashtra to start new Post Graduate Course of Study in 07 subjects viz. (i) *Samhita Siddhant*, (ii) *Kriya Sharir*, (iii) *Dravyaguna*, (iv) *Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana*, (v) *Kaumarbhritya*, (vi) *Agad Tantra* and (vii) *Panchakarma* with 06 seats in each subjects and to increase the admission capacity from 50 to 60 seats in existing UG course, from the academic session 2014-15 to the academic session 2018-19 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970. Therefore, the college may take admissions for the academic session 2014-15 and onwards.

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2. This permission to increase the admission capacity in existing UG course and to start new Post Graduate Courses in 07 subjects as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2014-15 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.

3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers, as prescribed in the relevant CCIM Regulations are in position before the admission of the students in the above-mentioned courses as per permitted UG/PG seats are made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

4. Further, to obtain the permission for academic session 2019-20 onwards and to take admissions in the above said new permitted 07 PG courses and the increased intake capacity in existing UG course, the college shall maintain all the Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations, 2013, provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder, in toto during the period of permission (i.e. up to 2018-19) as intimated by Department vide letter no.R.17011/153/2014-EP (IM-1) dated 04.08.2014 which may be verified either by the Central Government or by the Central Council of Indian Medicine on receipt of any complaint. Further, as per the provisions of Sub-Regulation (2) of Regulation 3 of the MSR Regulations, 2012, the Central Council shall visit the college *suo moto* three months before the expiry of permission to verify the requisite infrastructure and facilities required under above mentioned Regulations by means of an inspection and shall submit a report to the Department of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.
