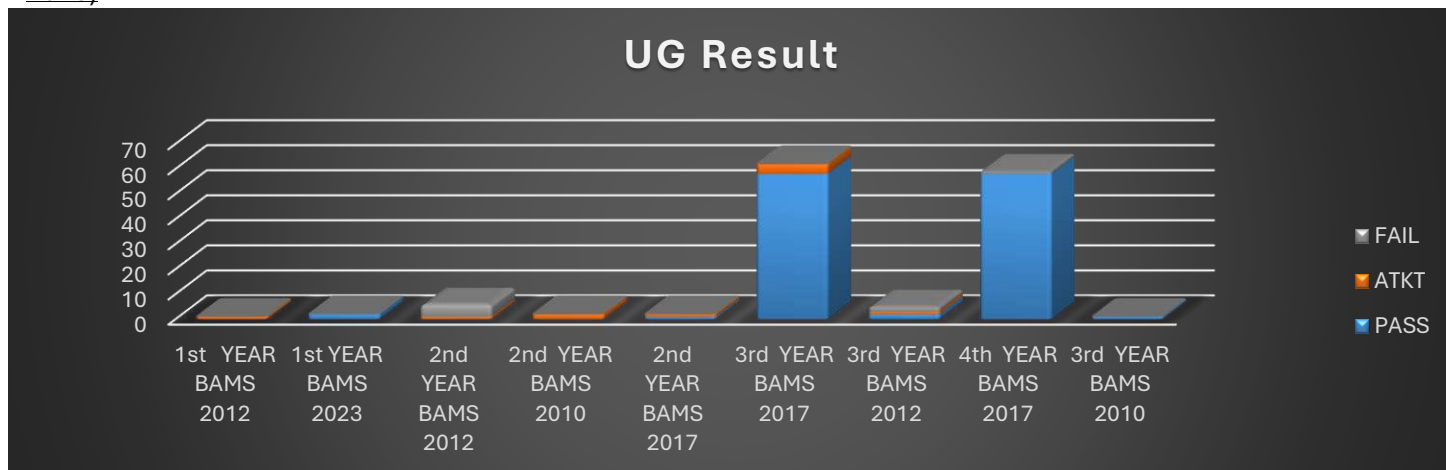

**Graph no 1:-** Showing Pass, Fail & ATKT students from total appeared student’s year wise (2010, 2012, 2017 & 2023)





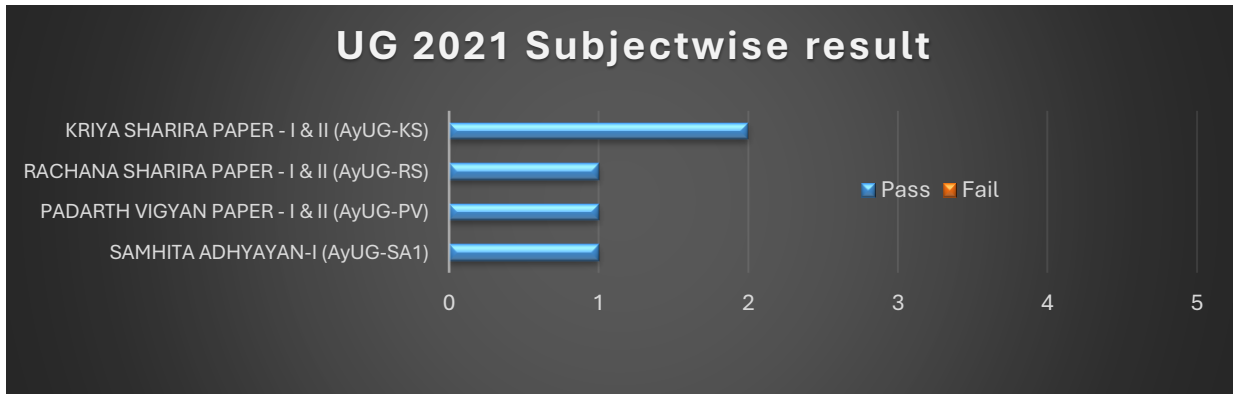

**Graph no 2:- Showing Pass, Fail students from total appeared student’s subjectwise (2021)**



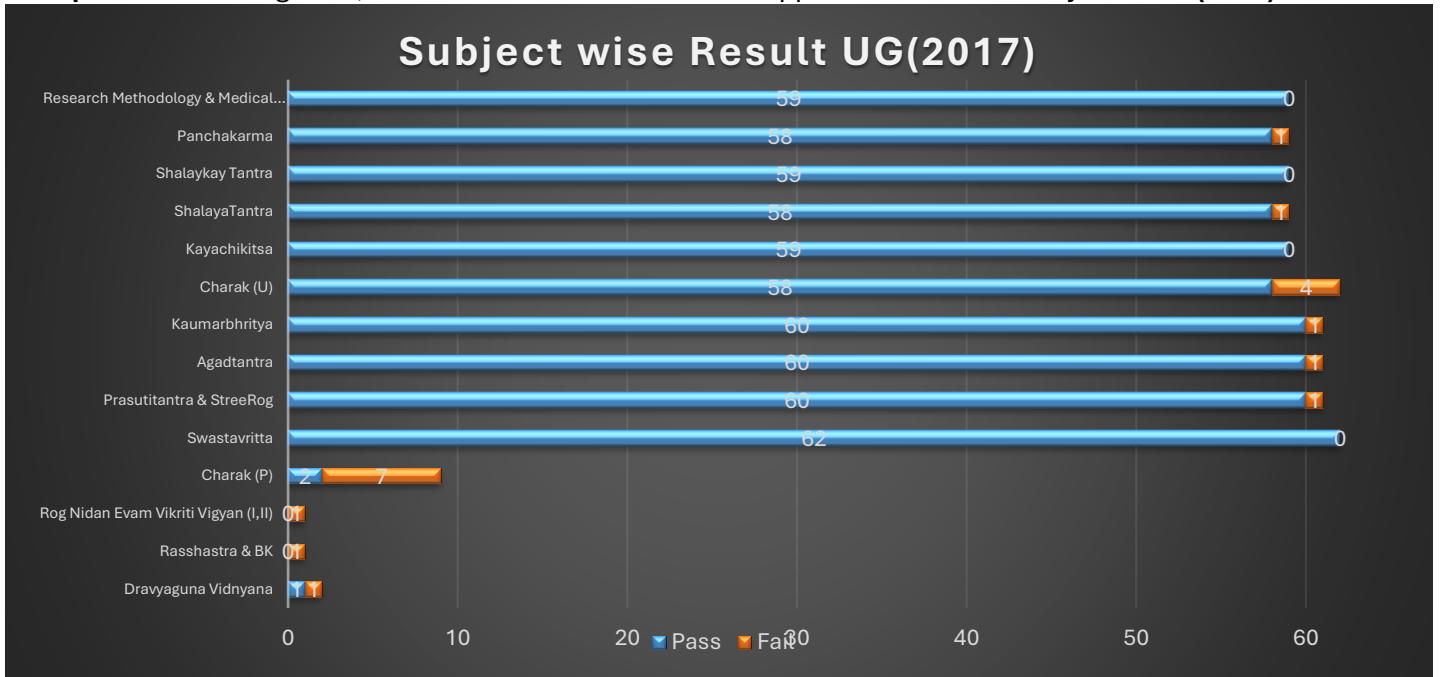

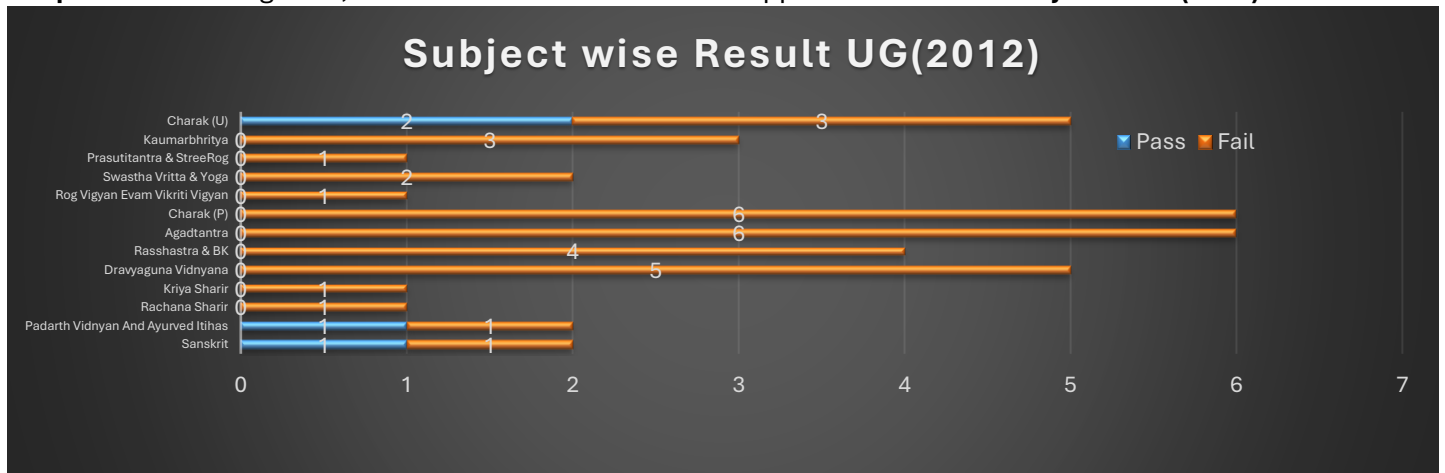
**Graph no 3. Showing Pass, Fail & ATKT students from total appeared student's Subject wise.(2017)**

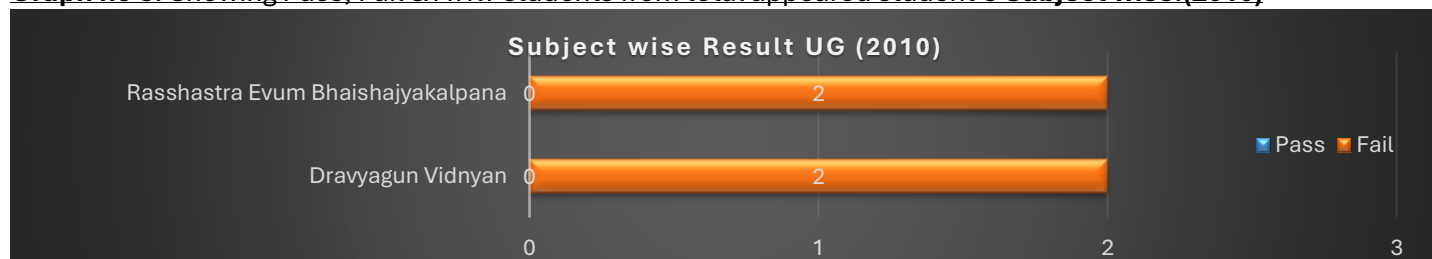

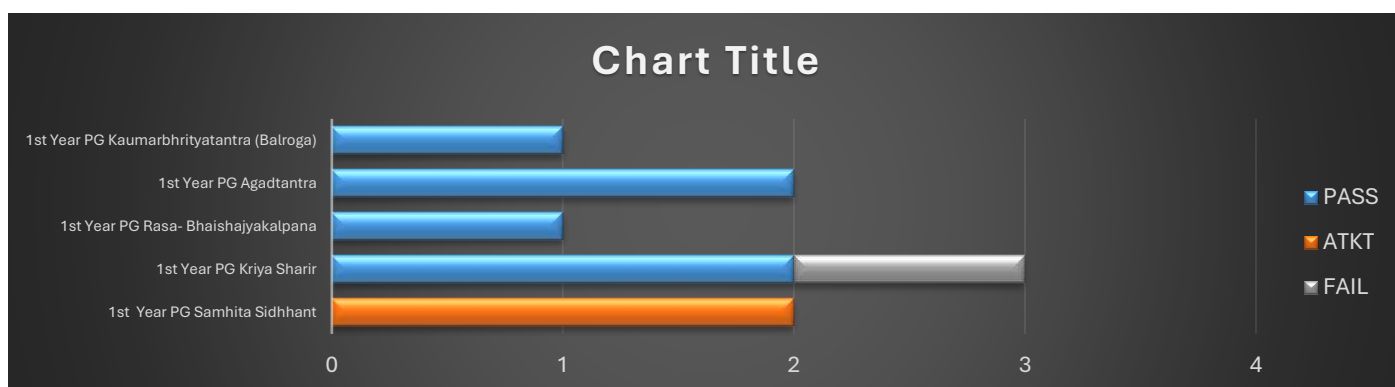

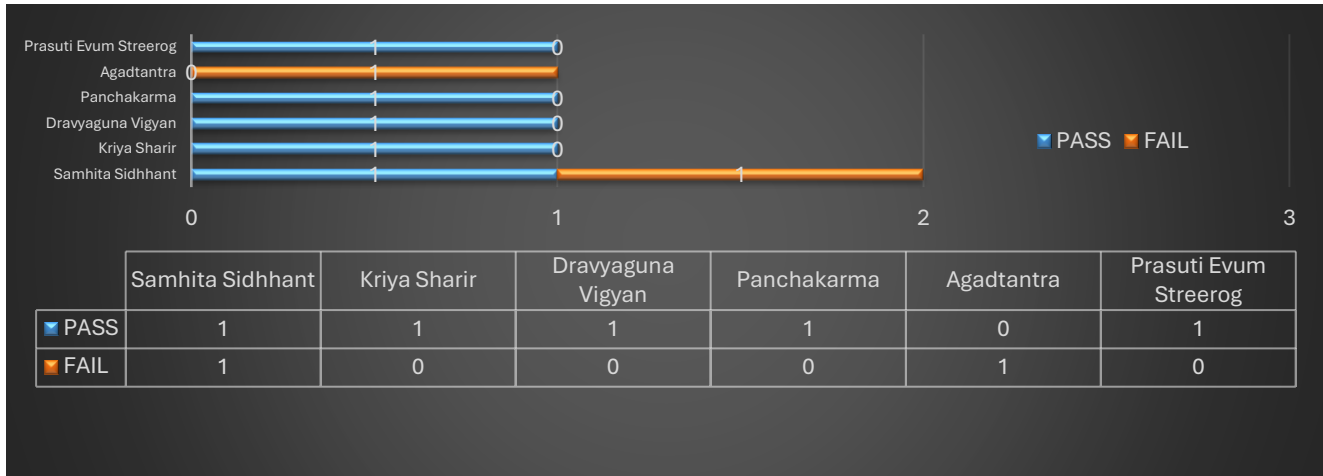

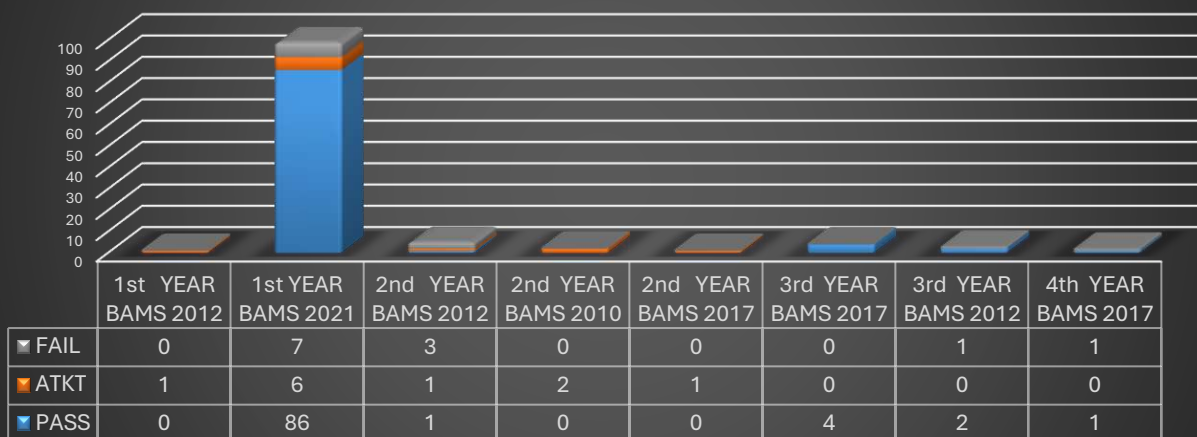

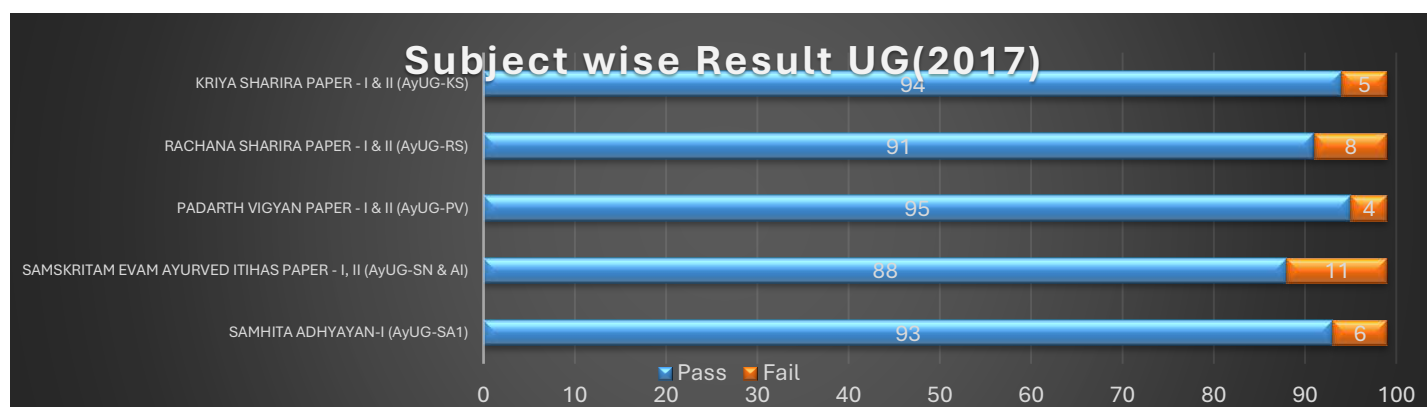

Graph no 3. Showing Pass, Fail & ATKT students from total appeared student's Subject wise.(2017)

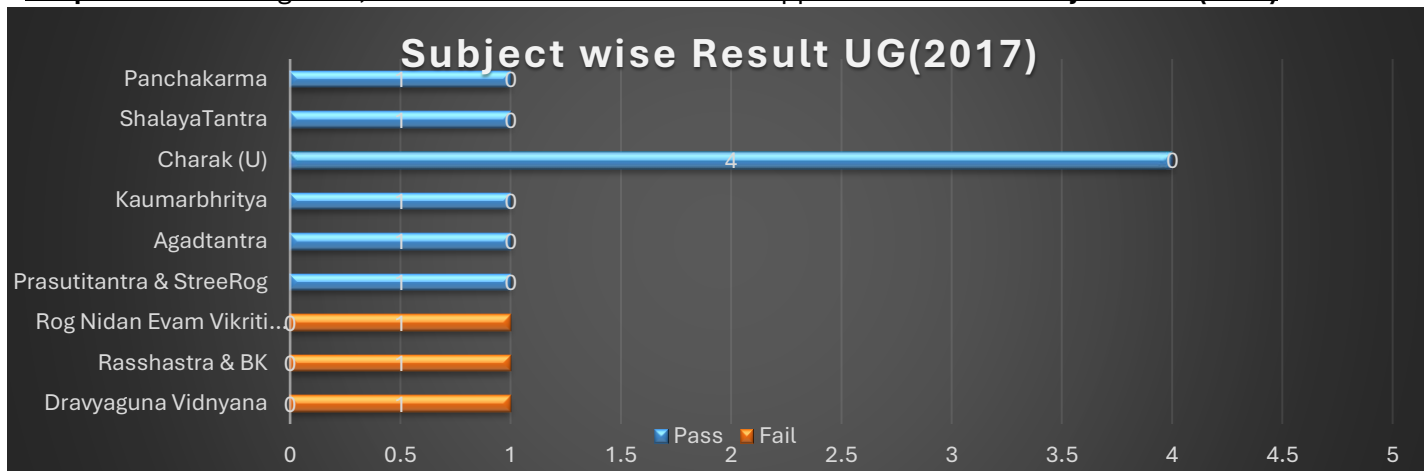
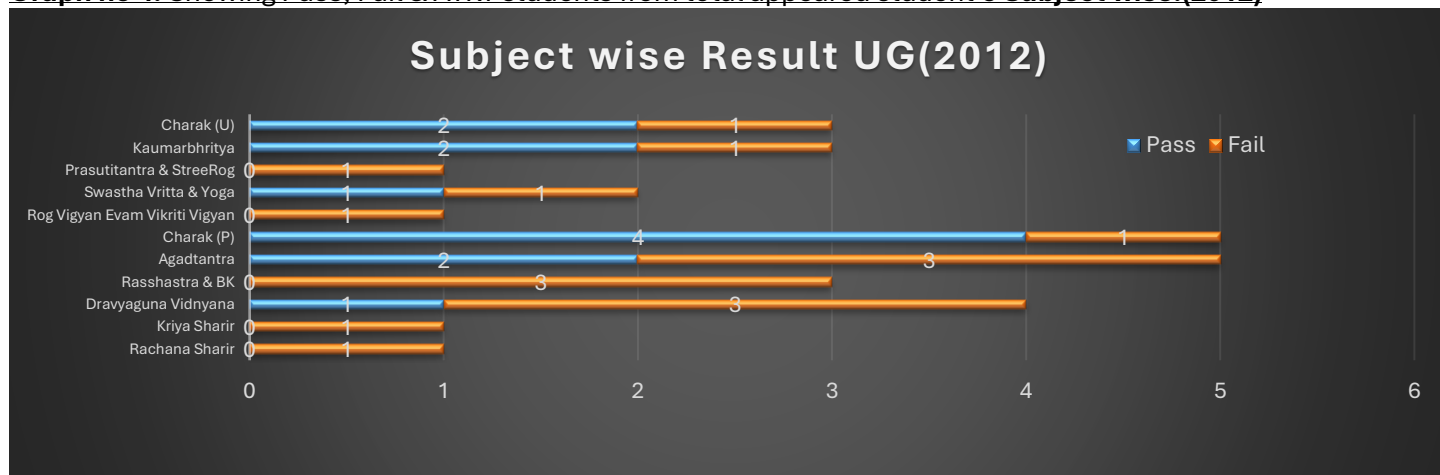

Graph no 4. Showing Pass, Fail & ATKT students from total appeared student's Subject wise.(2012)



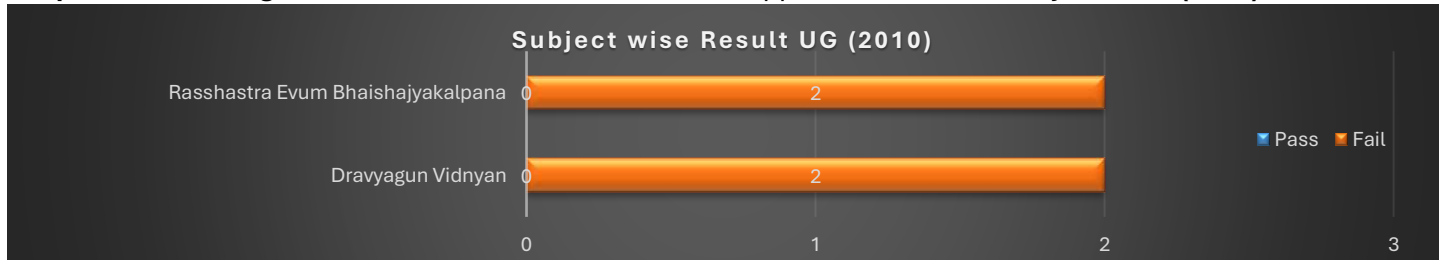

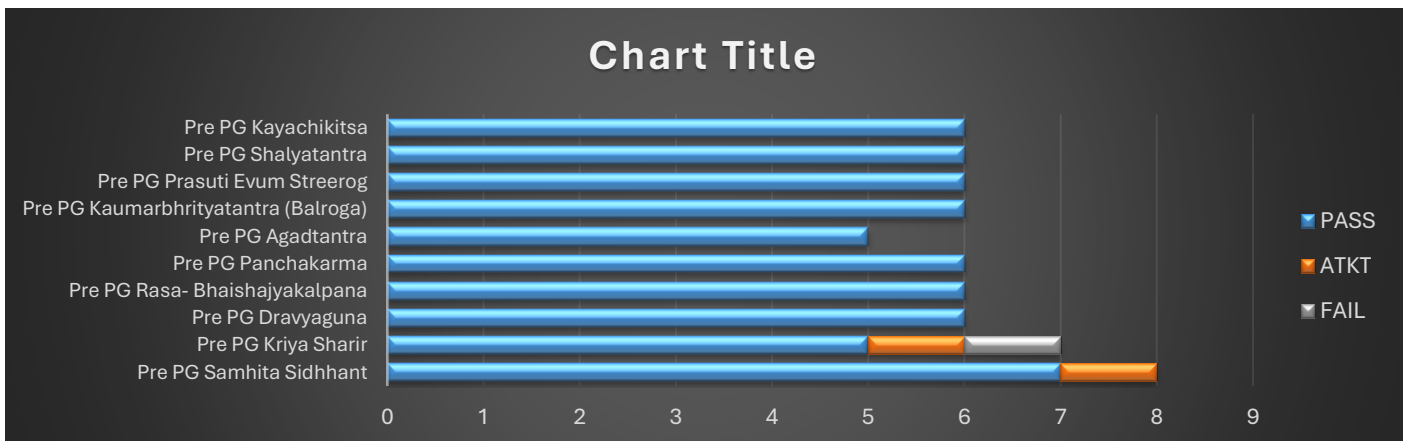

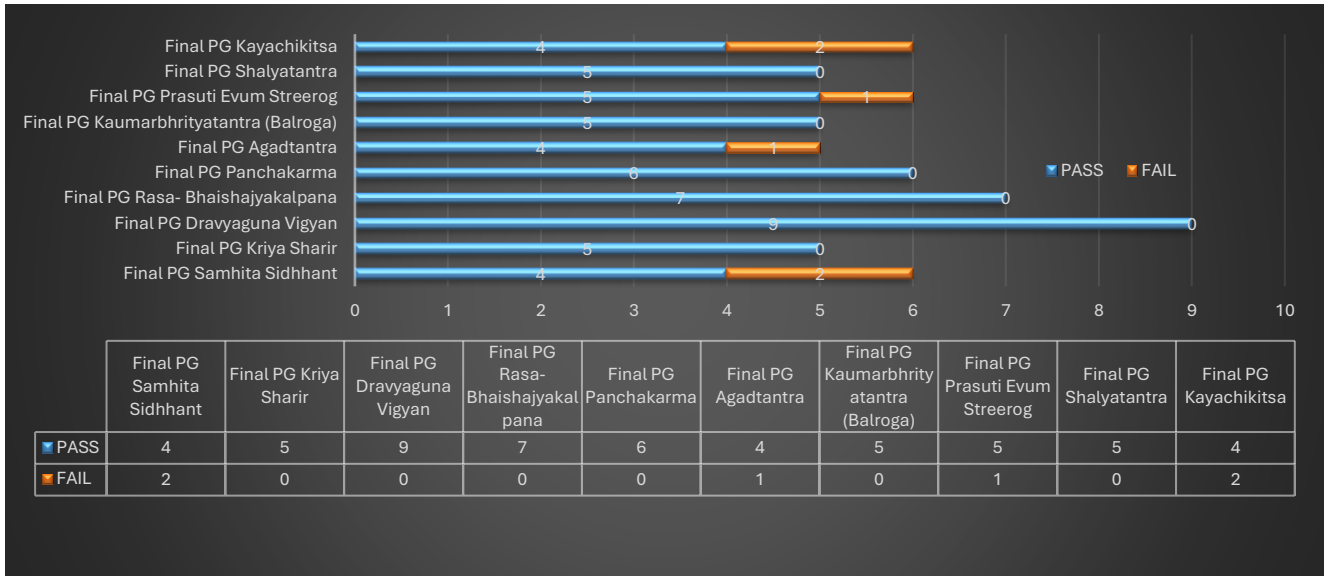

The zoo is home to over 1,000 animals from 98 species, including endangered species, indigenous species, and animals from Africa. Some of the animals include: Lion-tailed macaque Nilgiri langur, Indian rhinoceros, Asiatic lion, Royal Bengal tiger, White tiger, Leopard, Asian elephants, Giraffes, Hippos. The zoo has a natural lake with wooded landscapes that is home to 93 species of birds, including many migratory birds.

The zoo has a snake farm called "The Reptile House" that exhibits both poisonous and non-poisonous snakes, including seven anacondas. The zoo also has a museum, and is a good place for picnics, family outings, and educational trips. There are over 35 species of snakes with other 10 species of reptiles like king cobras, spectacled cobras, Indian rock pythons, rat snakes, and sand boas.

## 'Desh Ka Prakruti Parikshan Campaign'
