8.1.6 The institution has taken adequate measures for the preservation and propagation of rare and endangered medicinal plants as per the list provided by the National Medicinal Plant Board

Institute has taken adequate measures for the preservation and propagation of rare and endangered medicinal plants. Following is the summary of measures taken

- Organizing the guidance session on how to protect rare species and importance of these species in our future
- Availability of documentation of rare and endangered plant list by IUCN and for the plants in Western Ghats of Maharashtra.
- Restricting human activities which may cause damage to such plants.
- Institute has maintain its own garden where these endangered species are stored, protected and identified
- Currently development of the green house for the cultivation of these species in our garden is in process.
- Provisions are made for the facility of sufficient water supply at the institute's garden.
- Activity of cultivation of the rare medicinal plants is taken.
- For awareness of cultivation and conservation of medicinal plants, the institute takes efforts through various activities.


Following is the list of rare medicinal plants cultivated at our garden -

Saraca asoca ,Gymnema sylvestre, Strehnos nux-vomica, Hemidesmus indicus, Celastrus panniculatus, Aquilaria malaccensis, Commiphora wightii, Coffea Arabica ,Rauwolfia serpentina , Cycas circinalis, Strobilanthes callosa etc.
